

# BIBLIOGRAPHY FOR SIGNIFICANT RELIGIOUS GROUPS IN AUSTRALIA

The literature on religion published in English is overwhelming. Much of it originates in the United States and the United Kingdom, and rarely refers to Australia. It includes translations of most of the basic texts of all the world religions. To this has been added a vast range of printed media, ranging from sermons to daily newspapers. In recent years, electronic media have added an array of websites and information. What is detailed here is only a selection of published books normally available in Australia, and referring directly or in passing to religions that operate or have operated in Australia. For greater detail, refer to the website of the religion or denomination of interest. References in languages other than English are not included here.

## Sources of data

The Schools Spirituality Project (2007) is a continuing project of surveys on spirituality in schools conducted by the Christian Research Association. As of December 2007, surveys had been conducted in 28 schools in four states of Australia and a total



of 4939 students had completed questionnaires, most of which were administered to whole classes of students through an internet-based survey system. The director of this project is Philip Hughes of the Christian Research Association.

The Wellbeing and Security Survey (2002) was conducted by Edith Cowan University, Deakin University and Anglicare (Sydney). It was made possible by a Collaborative Grant from the Australian Research Council. The research team included John Bellamy, Alan Black, Keith Castle, Philip Hughes, Peter Kaldor and Sue King. The survey was conducted among a random sample of Australians drawn from electoral rolls. There were 1514 people who completed the survey, an effective response rate of about 35 per cent.
