



## **Existing Research**

#### Not much

- Research primarily focused on specific student populations:
  - Seminary students (Duffy & Blustein 2005, Hernandez 2011, Hirsto & Buchert 2016)
  - Education students (Kilinc & Mahiroglu 2009)
  - STEM students (Moorman 2011)





## Why Regional, Remote and Rural?



Limited research exists on geographic location's impact on career development

- Rural/remote education is emerging as distinct field but not yet in career context
- Patton & McMahon note geographic location as underexplored in Systems Theory (2021)
- Educational institutions are primary influence on career decisions in rural/remote areas




### **Case Studies**

- 1x NSW Regional (96,500)
- 3x QLD Rural (69,500)
- 1x NT Remote (25,000)
- 2x WA Remote (51,000)




## **Religious Affiliation**

We typically see higher levels of religious affiliation in regional, remote and rural areas compared to their urban counterparts.

In addition, we tend to see higher levels of Faith Engagement in Regional, Remote and Rural schools compared to urban schools (Archer, in press).





## Qualitative Research

 Semi-structured interviews with focus groups across grades 10 – 12 in each RRR community.

 Questions organised into themes

 Analysed used a reflexive thematic analysis approach **Post-School Plans** 

**Community Expectations** 

**Geographic Location** 

Spiritual & Religious Beliefs

**Access to Career Advisors**
